In 1968 the Faith and Order division of the World Council of Churches and the Secretariat for Promoting Christian Unity (Roman Catholic) began preparing jointly materials for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.

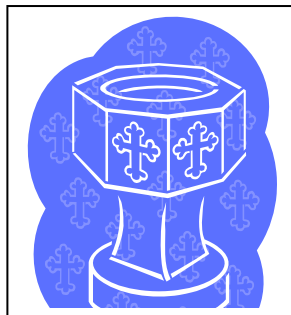
